



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Jamshedpur Women's College (Kolhan University) and CSIR-National Metallurgical Laboratory (CSIR-NML) hereinafter referred to as the Parties.

Desirous to undertake student internship program including faculty Training, motivation and adoption of College as per the Memorandum of Understanding reached between Jamshedpur Women's College and CSIR-NML on .../07/2016. Intending to establish the framework for a productive and mutual beneficial Knowledge exchange internship program before formal agreement;

Have reached the following understanding:

ARTICLE 1: Objectives

The purpose of the program is to provide an opportunity for students and teachers to apply educational leadership, S&T communication concepts and theories in a practical context.

ARTICLE 2: Implementation of Cooperation

1. The interns shall acknowledge that they have been given a unique opportunity to gain valuable professional experience.
2. Periodical visits to the college & Lab facilities by CSIR-NML Scientists.
3. The interns will fully observe the NML's regulations. If particular care is required so as not to damage the properties, facilities and equipment and to secure their safety, interns will follow all requirements and directions to be given by NML.
4. Exchange of knowledge in the form of one to one interaction, participation in Lab experimentation, workshop, training and demonstration.
5. NML appoints a supervisor for interns attending this internship program.

6. The supervisor provides learning assistance and supervision through out the internship program.
7. The supervisor informs the interns of their progress through timely evaluations.
8. Jamshedpur Women's College and CSIR-National Metallurgical Laboratory agree to make a work plan for the internship program, and to consult each other before making any major changes including the work plan.

ARTICLE 3 : Promotion of Interest, excitement and excellence in S&T Education.

The program may include, but are not limited to, such areas of mutual interest as:

1. Rising the standard of Science education.
2. Enhancing the Learning capabilities of students.
3. Motivation of working Faculty Members of the college with the participative Management approach.

NML trains intern students & Faculties in accordance with internship program which parties agreed in advance.

The interns must submit the training report after the end of this internship program.

The supervisor submits an evaluation report to Jamshedpur Women's College.
